# **Program Overview**

The University of Houston African American Studies Department's EMERGE Institute is an intensive leadership development program designed to prepare high school juniors and seniors with essential academic, professional, and leadership skills. The program emphasizes emotional intelligence, critical and strategic thinking, and collaborative learning. While open to all students, the EMERGE Institute is particularly designed to support students from historically underserved and underrepresented communities.

Instruction and mentorship will be provided by University of Houston faculty, African American Studies alumni, and distinguished community leaders.
