The maximum amount awarded per student will be \$750, to cover reasonable expenses. Prior completion of or current enrollment in WGSS 6301 is a plus. You must be a graduate student at UH at the time that the grant is expended.

Rolling Deadline. Decisions will be made quarterly (Sept 1, Dec. 1, March 1, June 1), until the available funds are expended. The committee may award less than requested, based on fund availability.

To apply for the WGSS travel grant, please submit the following:

- WGSS Program Graduate Student Travel Grant Application Form, completed in full. See below.
- Current CV.
- **Description** of project: In one typed page, please explain the project for which you are requesting funds and how this project relates to WGSS. The description should include the following information:
  - <u>For conferences</u>, the name of the conference, location, and your role in it. Please specify if you have had a paper accepted or are attending for another purpose. If presenting, include an abstract. Explain how your paper or participation relates to WGSS.
  - <u>For research projects</u>, please fully explain the proposed project and where you will be travelling to do the research (archive name, place, etc.).
- Full **budget**: Please include a full budget for the proposed conference travel or project, specifying any funding expected from other sources, both inside and outside the university.
