


### Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) Report

### What is SEVIS?

The Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) is a U.S. government internet-based system that tracks current information on non-immigrant students (F and M visas), exchange visitors (J visa), and their dependents (F-2, M-2, and J-2). SEVIS allows schools and program sponsors to transmit electronic information and event notifications via the internet to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and U.S. Department of State (DOS) throughout the student's/exchange visitor's stay in the United States. SEVIS reflects changes in international student or exchange visitor status, admission at the Port of Entry (POE), changes of address, changes in program of study, employment authorizations, and other events. Immigration forms I-20 (F visas) and DS-2019 (J visas) are also issued through SEVIS.

The International Student and Scholar Services Office (ISSSO) was responsible for maintaining records in SEVIS for students, scholars, faculty, and dependents for the **Fall 2024** semester that totals **6,208**.













### By Average Age Over Time










## 25 Year Non-Immigrant Enrollment Trends by Region



## Fall 2024 Curricular Pratical Training (CPT) Report

Curricular Pratical Training (CPT) is an opportunity for non-immigrant students to gain pratical work experience that is an integral part of their degree program. In order to be eligible for CPT, a department would either have to opt in for the experience track subplan and enroll in the University's COOP program, take a course that is part of the degree program and requires an internship or practicum experience to receive a grade, or be an essential part of a student's dissertation. CPT's are authorized per semester and a new application has to be approved for any subsequent semester that a student wishes to continue doing their practical training.


## F-1 Employment Statistics: Optional Practical Training (OPT)


Non-immigrant students on the F-1 visa have the option of pursuing a 12-month employment benefit, immediately following completion of their degree program. The student must apply with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for permission to work. The student is able to accept employment that is directly related to her/his major area of study for a specified time period, upon approval. This time period is referred to as Optional Practical Training (OPT). Students graduating from certain science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) disciplines designated by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security may be eligible for an additional 24-month extension for a combined 36 months of OPT. There are 1,839 F-1 alumni from 83 nations that participated in Optional Practical Training during Fall 2024.



### Open Doors Report Explanation

The next few pages contain information specific to International Student and Scholar Services Office's yearly reporting data to the Institute of International Education's (IIE) Open Door report. It depicts non-immigrant enrollment counts by country of origin and field of study for the Fall 2024 semester at the University of Houston. Field of study designations were determined based on the Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) Codes associated with the student's primary major. These codes are not specific to a certain college, and should not be compared in the same way. The following tables identify the trends for the top 25 sending countries to the U.S. for school year 2023/2024 and what role of incoming students UH has had for these sending countries and the current enrollment data that will be sent for fall 2024.

This page contains information regarding enrollment rank of the top 25 countries in the U.S. and how many of these students study at UH while the following two pages have information regarding the CIP code designations. As you will note, the top 25 sending countries to the U.S. are not the same as the top countries that are enrolled at the University of Houston. Iran, Nigeria, Mexico, Pakistan, and Colombia, for example, are higher ranked on the list for UH, but not in the entire U.S. On the opposite end, Brazil, Germany, Japan, Indonesia, UK, and Hong Kong are in the top twenty-five sending countries to the U.S., but has a small student population at UH.





### Language and Culture Center Enrollment: Fall 2024


The Language and Culture Center (LCC) is located on the University of Houston campus and provides students the ability to experience life at an American university while learning English as a Second Language (ESL) through a variety of courses designed to integrate them into the American educational system. LCC has provided intensive English instruction for international students on the University of Houston campus since 1975. LCC students may apply for admission to UH upon successful completion of the sixth and final level and passing TOEFL scores. Students enrolled in LCC programs are not enrolled in degree-seeking courses at UH and are therefore not included in the international student enrollment figures indicated earlier in this report. During the fall term of 2024, international students and permanent residents from 17 nations participated in the LCC program.


