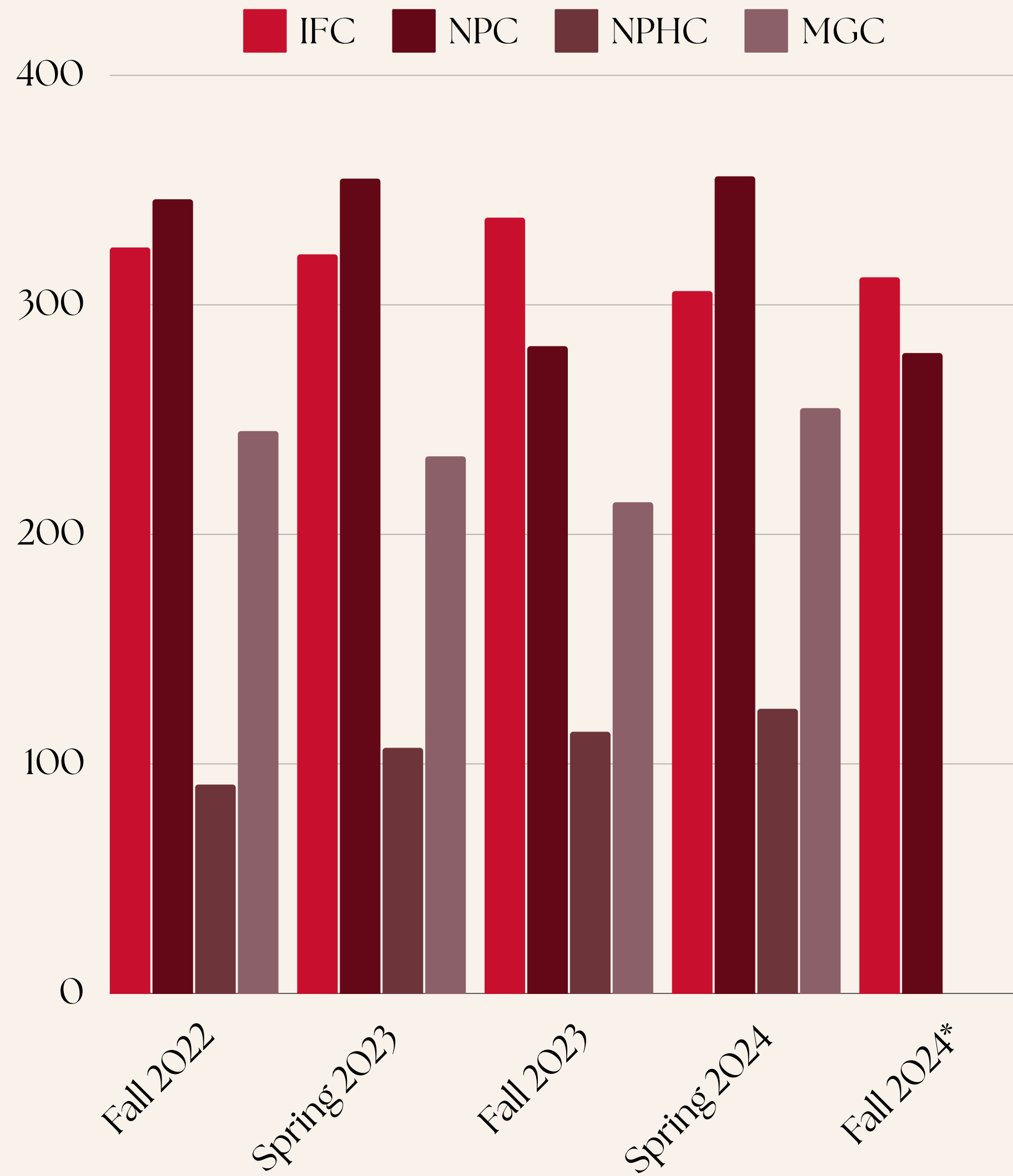

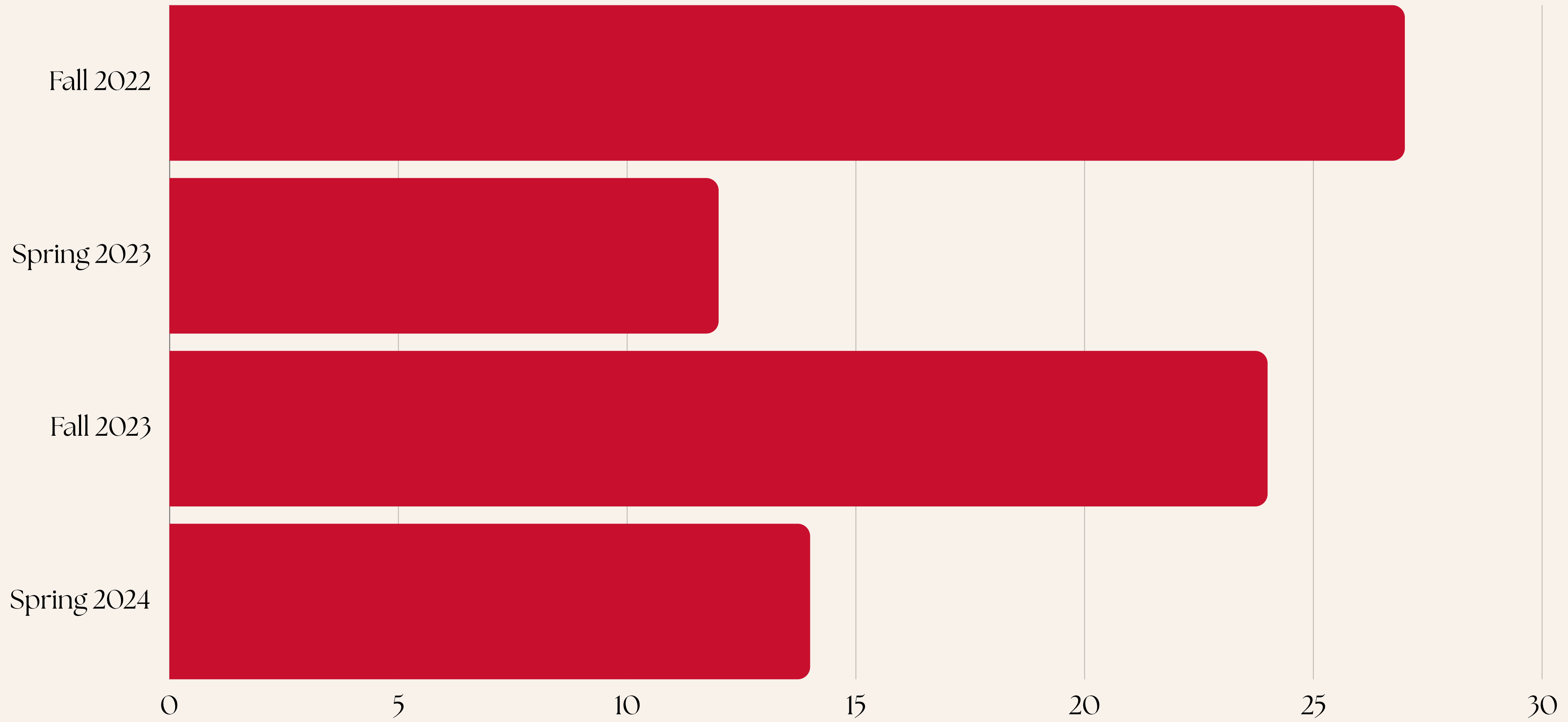

How to Join:

Houston Panhellenic Council (HPC)

Registration for recruitment is open from June 1 to September 12, 2024, with a \$75 fee. Panhellenic Primary Recruitment takes place in September. Students will meet the six chapters through a process of mutual selection.

Interfraternity Council (IFC)

Registration for recruitment will open August 12, 2024 with a \$10 fee. IFC Recruitment begins in the fall semester, starting with an IFC sponsored event, Open House and many different recruitment events hosted by individual fraternities in the community.

Multicultural Greek Council (MGC)

MGC organizations will be hosting various programs in the beginning of the semester to connect with students. For updates on the various programs follow them on Instagram @uh_mgc

National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC)

NPHC hosts 'Meet the Greeks' - August 28, 2024. During this event, moderators go over the minimum requirements to join the organizations and best practices for showing interest in becoming a member. Keep up with more events and info by following their Instagram @uh_nphc

United Greek Council (UGC)

At the start of each semester, each organization has their own requirements for becoming a new member. They host their own informational sessions with members of the respective organization to allow potential new members to learn about the fraternity or sorority.

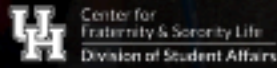

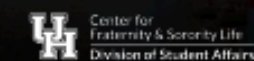

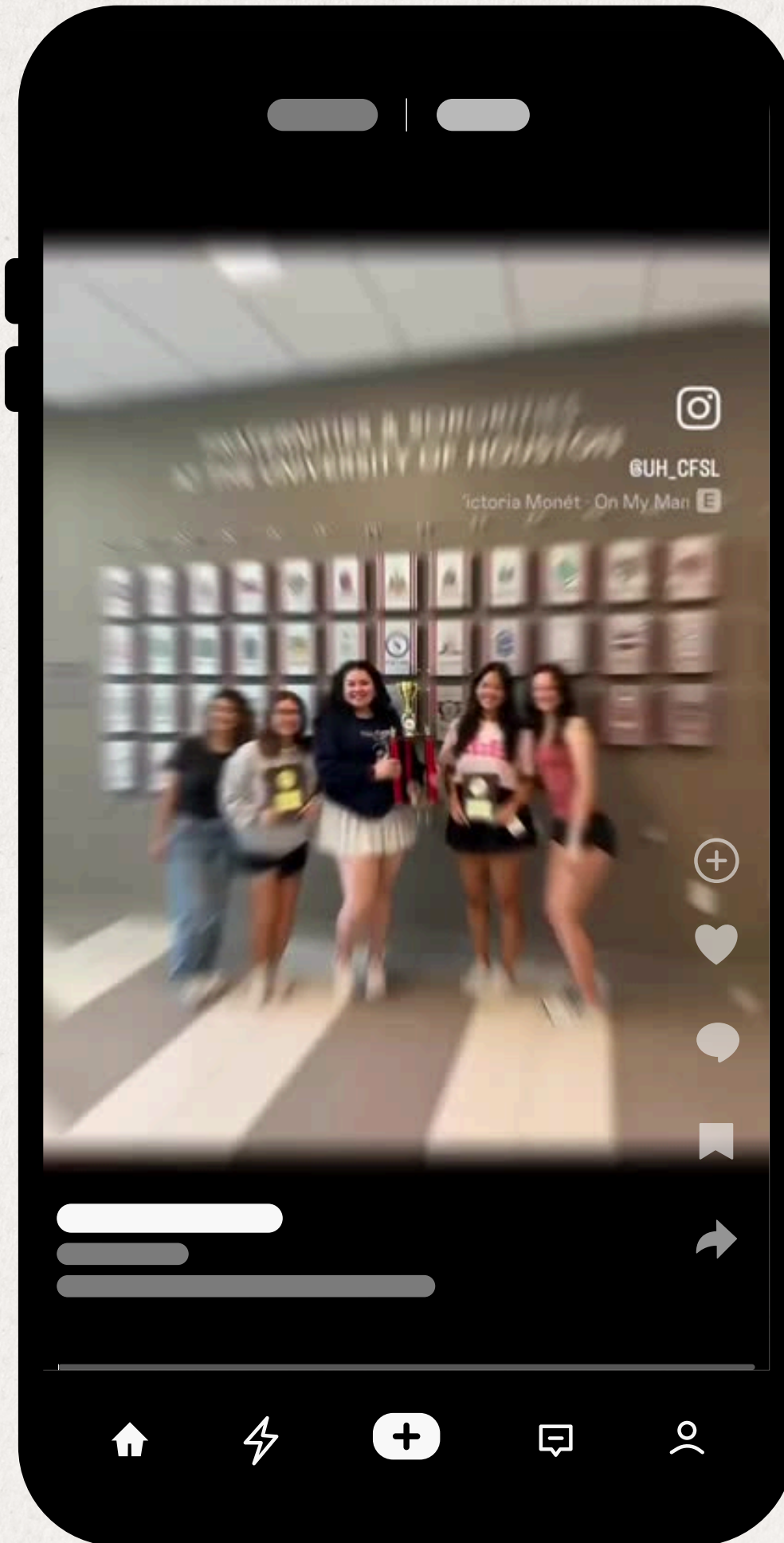


STUDENT EXPERIENCE

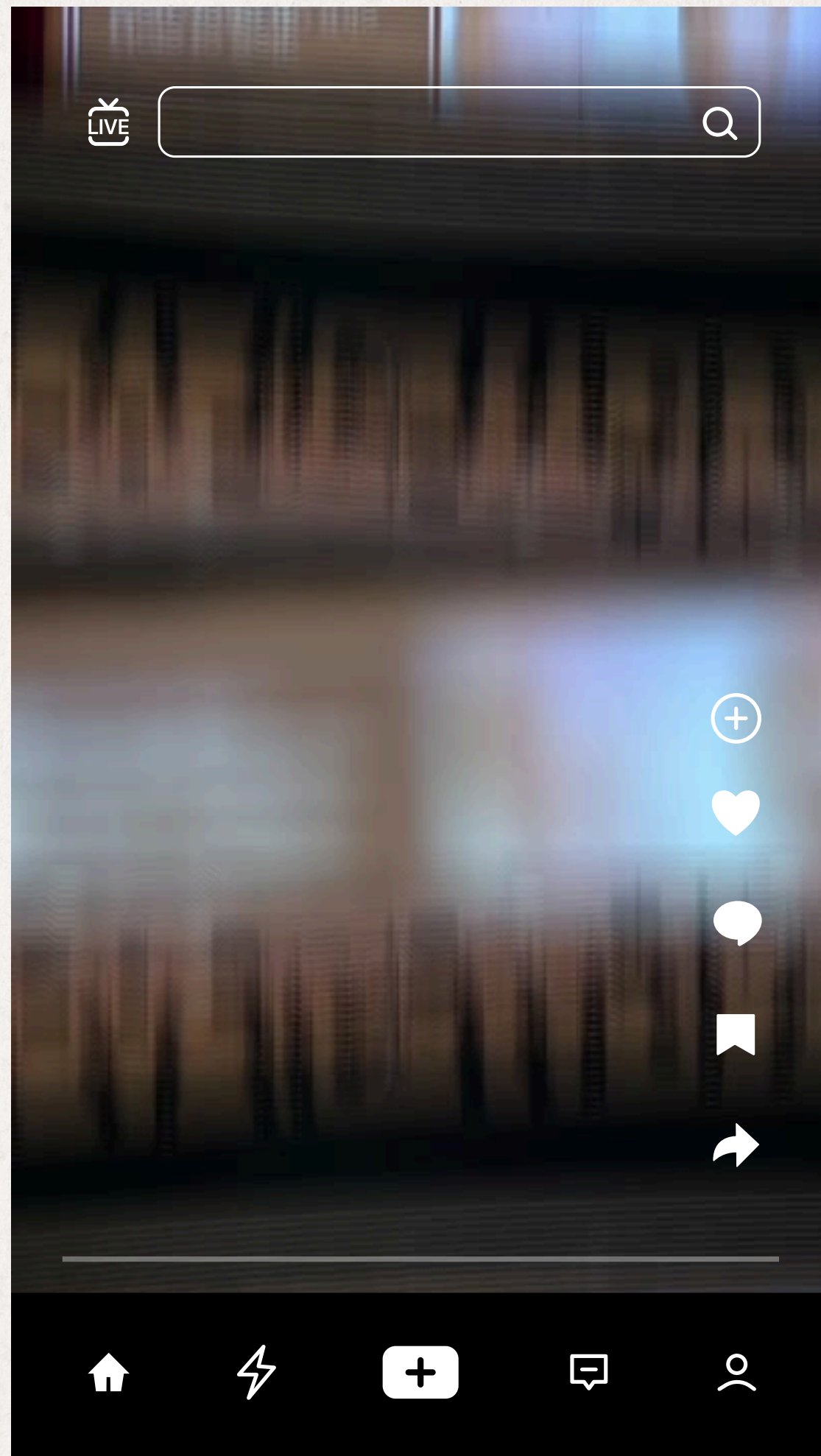
