However, the return of 5% of the DSA IT base budget has left limited resources for ongoing training and professional development—both of which are critical for staying engaged with the constant changes in technology and IT support.

Following recommendations from an External Review, we were tasked with expanding opportunities for our staff to enhance their professional development opportunities. This funding request will enable our team to engage in crucial opportunities, such as attending conferences and pursuing specialized technology training relevant to higher education systems. Additionally, it will continue to support the certification program for our student staff, ensuring they are well-equipped to handle modern IT challenges.

Outlined below is a list of opportunities for professional growth and certifications that we aim to achieve with this funding:
