SGA is requesting \$1,590 to cover the cost of a week of events open to all students organized by the SJL Emerging Leaders to promote student engagement, advocacy, and involvement in the community. \$1,500 would cover all the event expenses including, food, outreach/collaboration, marketing, decorations, etc and \$90 would cover the business and administrative fees.

Benefits:

- 1. **Community Engagement** SJL Emerging Leaders will have the chance to partner up with RSO's and other SFAC funded units to engage the community and promote advocacy and student engagement in the University
- 2. **Leadership Training** Students leading the project through the program would be able to learn how to lead a project that affects a community as well as time management, conflict management, teamwork, and budget administration.

3. **Education**- students who will be future leaders in the institution would be able to interact and engage with the student body and educate them about the importance of community engagement and advocacy
